June 29 - July 2 (4 DAYS)

PHOTOGRAPHY: Lights, Camera, Action!

Young photographers learn about the history of photography by exploring the work of great photographers, while also learning the fundamentals of composition, light, color, and movement to create memorable images. Key photographers in this study include those who mastered different styles and techniques, such as the storytelling of Steve McCurry, David Yarrow, Trent Parke, and Annie Leibovitz.

July 6 - July 10

OUTDOOR SCIENCE: Nature & Wildlife

Young naturalists explore the local flora and fauna of Port Washington's trails and Spectrum's lush garden and playground. Children embark on nature walks in search of diverse wildlife hidden in Port. Collect live samples, investigate findings with professional science equipment, and learn to appreciate the great outdoors.

**Parental permission is required for children in cohort 3 & 4 to be escorted on local nature walks.*

July 13 - July 17

NUMBERS IN NATURE: Math, Art, Nature

Young mathematicians explore the astonishing connections between geometry, art, and nature. Children discover how mathematics translates into stunning works of art found in museums and the great outdoors. Apply basic math concepts such as patterns and symmetry to create visual masterpieces, intricate structures, and tie-dyed T-shirts.

July 20 - July 24**ARTIST SERIES: Visual Art & Design**

Young artists explore the cutting-edge intersection between art, media, and culture. Children learn the distinct artistic styles and techniques of famous artists such as Picasso, Calder, Pollock, and other influential artists. Children demonstrate newfound knowledge by creating works of art inspired by these renowned artists.

July 27 - July 31**WORLD TRAVEL: A Global Expedition**

Young world travelers embark on an epic cultural adventure, exploring natural landscapes, famous landmarks, global fashion and customs from around the world. Children investigate various countries through multimedia research, storytelling, and music. Using art and building materials, children design and make unique projects inspired by their international discoveries.

August 3 - August 7**ANIMAL WORLD: Zoology & Ecology**

Young zoologists travel to diverse regions of Earth and explore rainforests, deserts, oceans, taigas, and grasslands in search of animals. Children investigate the vast collection of animals such as mammals, birds, reptiles, fish, and insects. Children discover the animals' special characteristics, adaptations, and behaviors and how it influences their interactions with each other and their environment. Create animal-themed projects and enjoy Spectrum's Petting Zoo.

August 10 - August 14**DINOLAND: Dinosaurs & Paleontology**

Young paleontologists explore prehistoric times when dinosaurs roamed the earth. Children investigate when, where, and how dinosaurs lived. Children discover amazing facts about these "terrible lizards," recreate the favorite Mesozoic era, excavate fossils, and answer the age-old question of whether or not dinosaurs are really extinct.

August 17 - August 21**COSMIC VOYAGE: Astronomy & Cosmology**

Young cosmologists blast off into the cosmos and explore the fascinating mysteries of outer space. Children discover how galaxies are formed, how stars are born, and why nothing can escape black holes. Explore the planets of the solar system, map-out constellations, and recreate NASA's greatest inventions.

Young scientists experiment and discover how multiple branches of science make and shape the world. Children explore chemistry, physics, biology, geology, and engineering through hands-on experimentation using safe lab-grade materials and equipment. Children engage in scientific research and hands-on projects as they witness, wonder, and widen their understanding of science.
